September reflection on our theme for this year: "Blessed" taken from Matthew's Gospel account of the Beatitudes

**Blessed are the meek and humble,  
for they will inherit the earth.**

Those who are humble will have more opportunities. This might seem counterintuitive. Many think humility and meekness is downplaying oneself. For instance, if someone suggests to serve at Church by being a Eucharistic Minister (giving communion) or a Lector (reading) being humble is not saying, "Oh, no I'm not worthy." That's not humility--that's a good way of not taking responsibility. Rather, to accept such an invitation leads to growth. You might not know how to do it, but if you are humble, you can learn. And by learning you will open yourself up to God's grace and grow. Thus, humility is an attitude of growth.

## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

In our Gospel passage from Luke, the Lord shows us how to bridge the gap between worldly thinking and priorities, and eternal thinking and priorities. Jesus tells the parable of the corrupt but clever steward who is about to get fired when the master discovers the steward has been squandering his property. Realizing his imminent unemployed status, the clever steward reaches out to the various debtors of his master to wheel and deal with them, making friends who would look out for him when he became jobless.

What if we put that kind of effort into our own tasks as good stewards of all God's gifts to us? Into our ministries, into the ways we could make more time for prayer as individuals, as couples, as families and as a parish? What if we got as creative as the "bad steward" in the use of our finances so that we could give more generously to the poor and to the advancement of God's kingdom on the earth?

That's our lesson and our challenge.


