

It's hard to believe that we are a week away from Palm Sunday! Where has this Lenten Season gone? It seems like Ash Wednesday was yesterday, and we were stumbling to get ourselves together to figure out what to "give up" or "to do" for Lent.

I hope this Lent continues to be a time of new awareness and renewal for each us. I pray that we have had an opportunity to discover where Christ is calling us to "Come Forth" from whatever cave of darkness... that unhealthy living has walled in and stifled.. to a freer path... where our actions can be reflections of God enfolded.... in faith, hope, and love.

In today Gospel Jesus enters into the stench of the death that surrounds his friends Lazarus, Martha, and Mary. He enters into the grief of Martha and Mary to the point of shedding tears, and also reminds them that he is "the Resurrection and the Life." With this powerful proclamation..... Jesus calls Lazarus back to life, and invites his family and community "to unbind him, and to let him go free"
