Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

f I could only touch the tassel of his garment, I will

be made whole". What a great statement of faith from today's Gospel. Jesus has been asked by an official's assistant to come and heal his daughter who is seriously ill. Jesus responds and along the way - through a pressing crowd.... is touched by a woman who has been impacted with illness for many years, is near to broke, and is seeking healing. He is curious and drawn to her persistence.

Even with her weaken condition... she has courage and great 'faith' and pushes through adversity.... to "touch his garments." That took a lot of energy and risk - to 'push forward' for something that could have failed! Jesus finds her and asks why did she do this? Fearful that she has been noticed, she comes forward and shares her story. Jesus only sees the power of her faith realized.

He continues on his journey to a sick little girl, and despite the doubt and fear of others.. He pushes through... to grasp the little girl by the hand, and says "Little girl, get up! The young girl rises, is fed, and returns to life with her family.
